- 4. <u>PLANNING CONSULTATION COMP/2021/01</u>: Proposed Penrhos Leisure Village Development. Received by Email from the Anglesey County Council on the 29 July 2021.

The Mayor, Councillor Richard Parry informed members of the Council that as this Planning application had already been approved some time ago, that this Planning Consultation was in respect of the Section 106 part of the Planning application, such as car parking, green linkages, ecology and tree management as such the Town Council could only make their comments known to the Planning Officer who would then further the comments onto the members of the Planning Committee of the Anglesey County Council. The Mayor added that not all the land in question would be developed upon and the rest of the land would be for woodland paths and forest areas.

These concerns should be rectified as soon as possible in order for the Town Council and the general public to be made aware of the Developer's proposed plans and processes."
