2. Apologies of Absence were received from Cllr Ailia Lewis MBE, Cllr Keith Roberts.

3. Declaration of Interest – Cllr Glyn Haynes declares an interest in item 7 on the Agenda regarding Planning Applications.

4. Mayors Announcements

Cllr Edwards informed the Committee of her commitments during the month, attending a meeting with Cruise Wales & the Welsh Government to discuss how we can better Tourism on the island. She also supported the Bikers2Macmillan Charity which took place at South Stack – Scarborough. Whilst also becoming part of the Veterans Committee which met at Llanfaelog village hall. 5. Crown Update from Efan Milner

Efan presented the committee with a presentation to show how the future crown site would look. He informed the committee that the Council had received back drawings of the memorial statues that will be placed at the site and would now need confirmation from the Town Council that they are suitable for the area. It was resolved that members of the Town Council would need to report back to the Town Clerk within a week's time with their input and any changes they would like to make. Minute No.6034/2026

6. Report from Maes Hyfryd Councillors Surgeries

Cllr Susan McGinn and Cllr Hughes both updated the Council on their findings from the Surgeries held at Milbank Community Centre. They also informed the committee that they have been asked to join the Committee for the Treseifion Park. Both Councillors believe that holding the surgeries have a huge impact on the ward and recommend that each ward holds surgeries during the month. Minute No. 6035/2026

7. Bike Track Proposal

The Clerk informed the committee that himself and the Grants officer are looking into funding to place a bike track in Morawelon. The clerk informed the committee that they would be kept up to date with the progress of his findings. Minute No. 6036/2026

8. Y Bark Update

The Clerk informed the committee of the dog park planning which was brought to the officers back in April. Having sought advice from the County Council. The dog park does not need a change of use and it is classed as a refurbishment. All the correct protocols were followed during the process of setting up Y Bark and it has become a successful enterprise for the Town. Minute No.6037/2026

9. Boston Centre Stage

The Clerk informed the committee that they Town Council have now successfully taken over the Boston Centre Stage. The intentions are to continue running it as it has been but with the possibility of turning it into a CIO. He informed the committee that once the CIO is established, the town council can step away and it can be run by the Trustees whilst bookings can be taken through the main Council office.
